

## Family autumn walk

Encourage children to go on a hunt for autumn treasures with their family and show you their finds with this activity provided by NDNA Member Granby House Nursery\*.

### Learning aims

- Promote partnerships with parents
- Explore the outdoors and understand the importance of this for health and development
- Talk about what they see and find, notice similarities and differences between what they have found
- Begin to talk about past and present events.



### Resources

- Small paper bag for each child with a short message attached.

### Activity Outline

1. Provide each child/family with a small paper bag
2. Add a short message asking them to go on a family walk to find autumn treasure
3. Encourage them to email a family selfie for an autumn display
4. Encourage them to bring back their treasures to look at and display in nursery.

### Extending the activity

- Maths – sort and count what they have found
- Expressive arts and design – use the natural objects they have collected to create artwork e.g. painting with leaves or creating images and designs using sticks, leaves and flower
