Other times that NDNA will collect personal information from you through our website is if you send an enquiry, provide us with feedback or fill a form out requesting further information. We may use these details to contact you about NDNA products and services. We will not share this information with third parties for marketing purposes.

We may collect and record some information in order to understand more about how our site is used. In order to do this, we may send cookies to your PC. Cookies are text files that let us identify your computer. We do not identify any personal information through cookies. You can disable this function within your browser by using the instructions below:

Internet Explorer 6.0

1. Select Tools, then Internet Options
2. Click the Privacy tab
3. Click on Custom Level
4. Click on the 'Advanced' button
5. Check the 'override automatic cookie handing' box and select Accept, Block or Prompt for action as appropriate.

Internet Explorer 5.0 or 5.5

1. Select Tools, then
2. Internet Options
3. Click the Security tab
4. Click on Custom Level
5. Scroll down to the sixth option to see how cookies are handled by IE5 and change to Accept, Disable, or Prompt for action as appropriate.

Internet Explorer 4.0

1. Select View, then Internet Options
2. Click the Advanced tab
3. Scroll down to the yellow exclamation icon under Security and select one of the three options to regulate your use of cookies.

Netscape 6.0

1. On your Task Bar, click: Edit, then Preferences
2. Click on Advanced
3. Click on Cookies.

Firefox 2.0

1. Open the Tools menu
2. Select Options
3. Select the Privacy tab
4. Remove the check mark from 'Accept cookies' field
5. Click OK.

Firefox 1.x

1. Open the Tools menu
2. Select Options
3. Select the Privacy tab
4. Click the View Cookies and in the 'Cookies' area and remove the check mark from the box next to 'Allow sites to set cookies'
5. Click OK.

Mozilla

1. Open the Edit menu and choose Preferences
2. Under the Privacy & Security category, choose Cookies (if no subcategories are visible, double click the category to expand the list)
3. Put the radio buttons for 'Block cookies'
4. Click OK.
