

# Activity

## Learning about seasonal clothing activity

A changing season is a great opportunity to talk to children about the clothing needed to keep them warmer/cooler.

### Learning aims

- Understanding the world learning about the seasons
- Language and communication using a range of vocabulary.

#### Resources

- A box or a bag to store the clothes
- A selection of children's clothing from the changing seasons:
  - Wellies
  - Sandals
  - Scarves, gloves, mittens
  - o Vests
  - Woolly socks and cotton ankle socks
  - o Summer cap
  - $\circ$  Winter hat.

#### **Activity Outline**

- 1. Talk to your children about the changing weather and how it feels
- 2. Have them think back to a different season e.g. playing outdoors in the warmth after putting on sun cream
- 3. Talk about the types of clothes they wore e.g. sun hats, woolly hats
- 4. Ask your children how the weather made them feel e.g. the warm sunshine may have made them happy
- 5. Discuss the current weather and ask your children to talk about what they are wearing
- 6. Bring out your box/bag of clothes and ask the children to sort them into clothes you can wear on a hot day and clothes you can wear on a cool day
- 7. Move on to talk about ways to keep warm in the cold weather such as taking part in physical activity.
