



## 8 tips for gardening on a budget

Getting involved in gardening projects does not have to cost a lot of money.

- Ask local farmers and local garages/tyre companies for old tyres (different sizes and shapes) to use for planting

- 7. Install your own compost bin
- 8. Use a water butt to collect rainwater for the plants.
