Exploring different countries in your setting? Check out our tips:

- Ask the children what they think the country may be like and find it on the map/globe.
- Look up their flags and create the flags for your own Olympic Games. What colours and shapes are in the flags, what other flags have the same colours?
- Think about themed days for food, work with your chef to decide on dishes from countries the children have been looking at. Try these with the children talking about the country of origin and what the children can remember about that country.
- If the children are engaged why not create your own book about the different countries, you have looked at? You could include flags, food, places in the country, any traditional dress and the money they use. You can add to this as you learn about different countries throughout the year.
